11. Old and New Business

- a. **Twin Pines Line Extension: Follow-up with Public Questions:** General Manager Houghton addressed the questions asked by the public from March's meeting stating:
 - The public input item was placed at the beginning of the meeting because this was a change made a few years ago due to public complaining that they did not want to sit through the meeting to address the Board, feeling it was a tactic the Board used to discourage public from attending.
 - The District is approximately three months into the process of obtaining a grant for the Twin Pines Line Project and currently working with Provost and Pritchard to see whether the District should request a State or Federal grant.
 - He stated that a prescriptive easement allows someone other than the original property owner to gain the rights to use a property, which are common in rural land.
 - Defined that a commercial account is any account that uses the water, or intends to use the water, to make any type of profit. This was implemented in 2018 and followed all the guidelines of Proposition 218.
- b. **Review of Legal Letter from Law Attorney Alec Harshey:** The Board reviewed the letter from both Alec Harshey as well as a letter from Steve Chittenden and two letters from the High Valleys Water District dated in 1970 and 1971. No comments from the Board were given.
- c. **SGPWA Update:** The main discussion at this meeting was about materials and how difficult it is to find, primarily pipe. They also discussed the Chromium -6 rule and that The City of Banning, where the District purchases their water from for distribution, has wells that are above the new standard of 10ppb (parts per billion). - d. **CPA Update:** Former CPA Linda Glau contacted the office to recommend Sarah Hines, whom she has worked with. Secretary/Office Administrator Thornton spoke with Ms. Hines and offered her the position, which she accepted. Her rate will be \$75.00 per hour, which is significantly less than the former CPA's rate.
